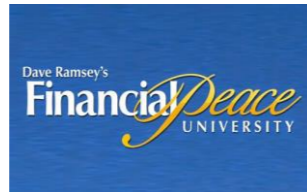

sending disciples out into our community and beyond, for followers of Christ are intended to go out in mission and service as God’s co-workers in the field.

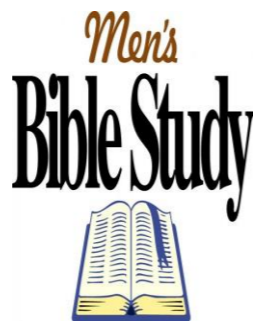
